Information Service Manual

For King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi students



This manual has been prepared to introduce the information services of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi, provided by the Computer Center. It outlines the services and basic usage methods of various information systems and services available to students throughout their studies at King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi.



KMUTT Account



The key to accessing various information services of the university.

KMUTT Account is used to verify identity when accessing the information systems of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi and the information services provided by the Computer Center.

All KMUTT students will receive a KMUTT Account once they are assigned a student ID and their student records are properly registered. The account is in the format **name.surname@kmutt.ac.th** (the first four characters of the surname). In case of duplicates, additional characters from the surname will be added. Students must register to create their own password.



In case you forget your KMUTT Account password ?..

- 1 Enter your student ID in the “Username” field and click the “Check” button.
- 2 Check your personal email provided and confirm it.
- 3 The system will send a link to the personal email provided.
Click the received link and set a new password.

Authentication

Authentication refers to the security measures for accessing the information systems of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi (KMUTT) and the information services provided by the Computer Center. It is a process for verifying the identity of users accessing general systems, using a username and password. There are two types of authentication as follows

Authentication by using the “Student ID” as the username.

Example

Username : 66103874001
Password : xxxxxxxxx

KMUTT e-Mail

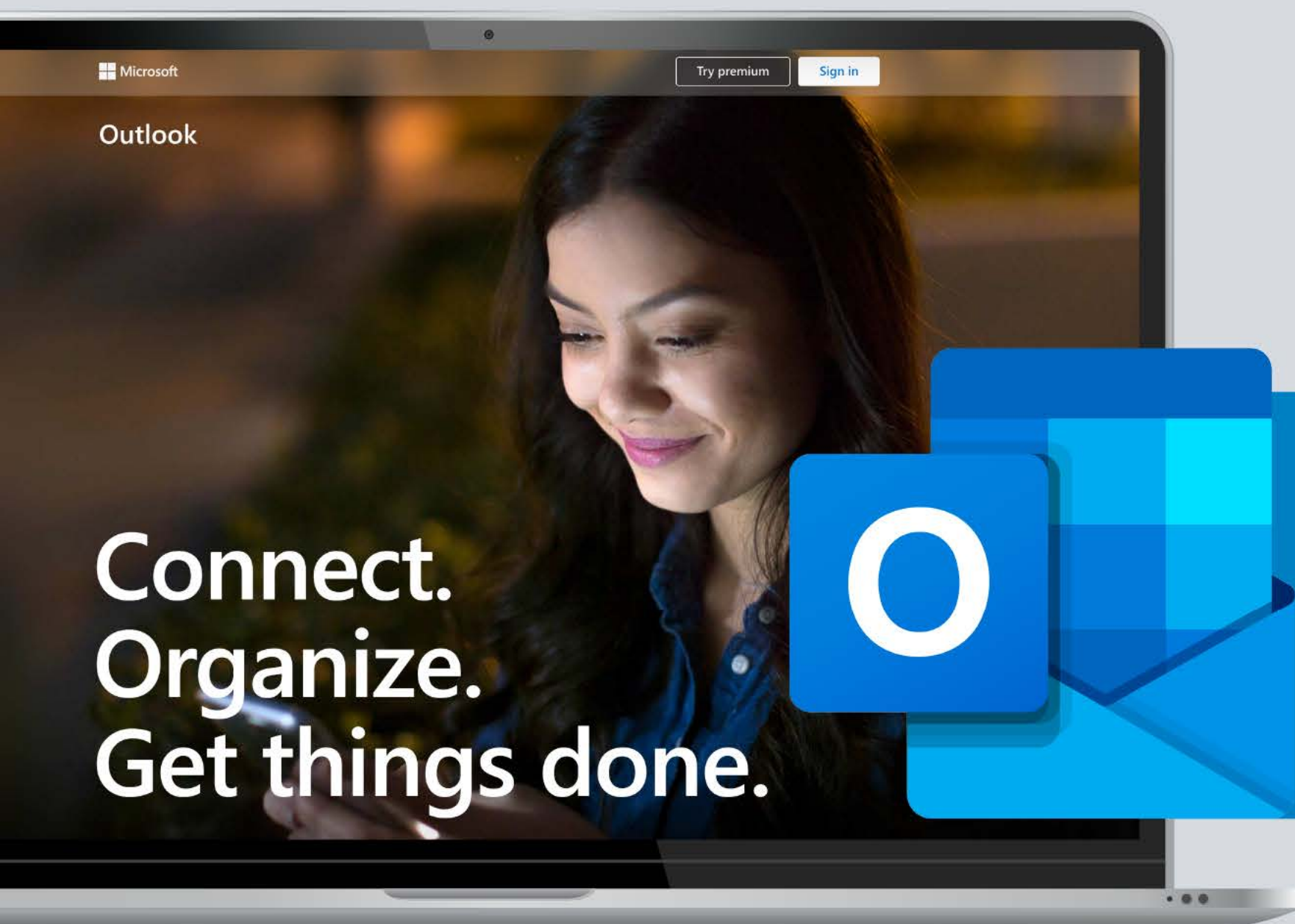
KMUTT e-Mail is the official email of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi, provided under the @kmutt.ac.th domain for all current students. Graduates can continue to use their KMUTT email after graduation through [Microsoft Outlook](#)

e-Mail Account is provided and managed by the Computer Center to facilitate the exchange of important information for the university. It is in the format of **name.surname@kmutt.ac.th** (the first four characters of the surname). In the case of duplicates, additional characters from the surname will be added.

It features a variety of collaborative tools, such as

- The ability to send and receive messages and attachments, with a limit of 25 MB per message.
- A mailbox storage capacity of 10 GB.
- The option to create appointments and events on the calendar, which can send reminders for scheduled meetings.

KMUTT Wi-Fi

KMUTT Wi-Fi service for students of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi. To support comprehensive access to the university's network systems throughout the university campus.

Divided into three network names based on frequency (SSID) as follows

KMUTT-AIS

is for the public areas on the ground floor of every building within the Bang Mod campus.

KMUTT-SecureN and KMUTT-Secure

are for other floors of every building across all educational areas.

Eduroam is a global roaming network service for education and research that facilitates students from member institutions to access wireless networks.

KMUTT VPN

It can be installed on PCs, Macs, tablets, and smartphones

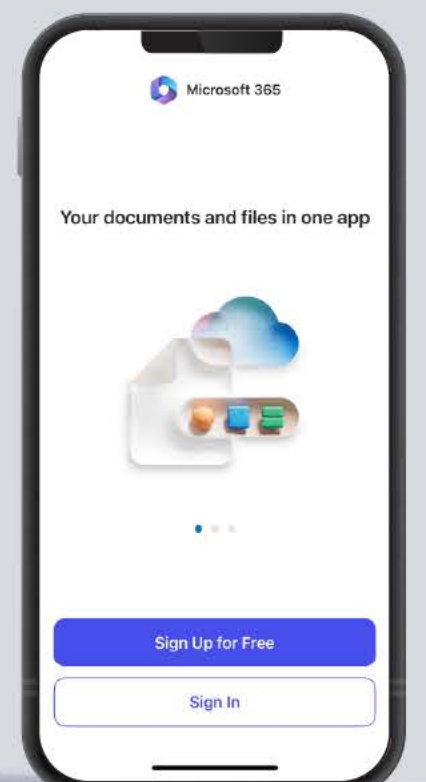
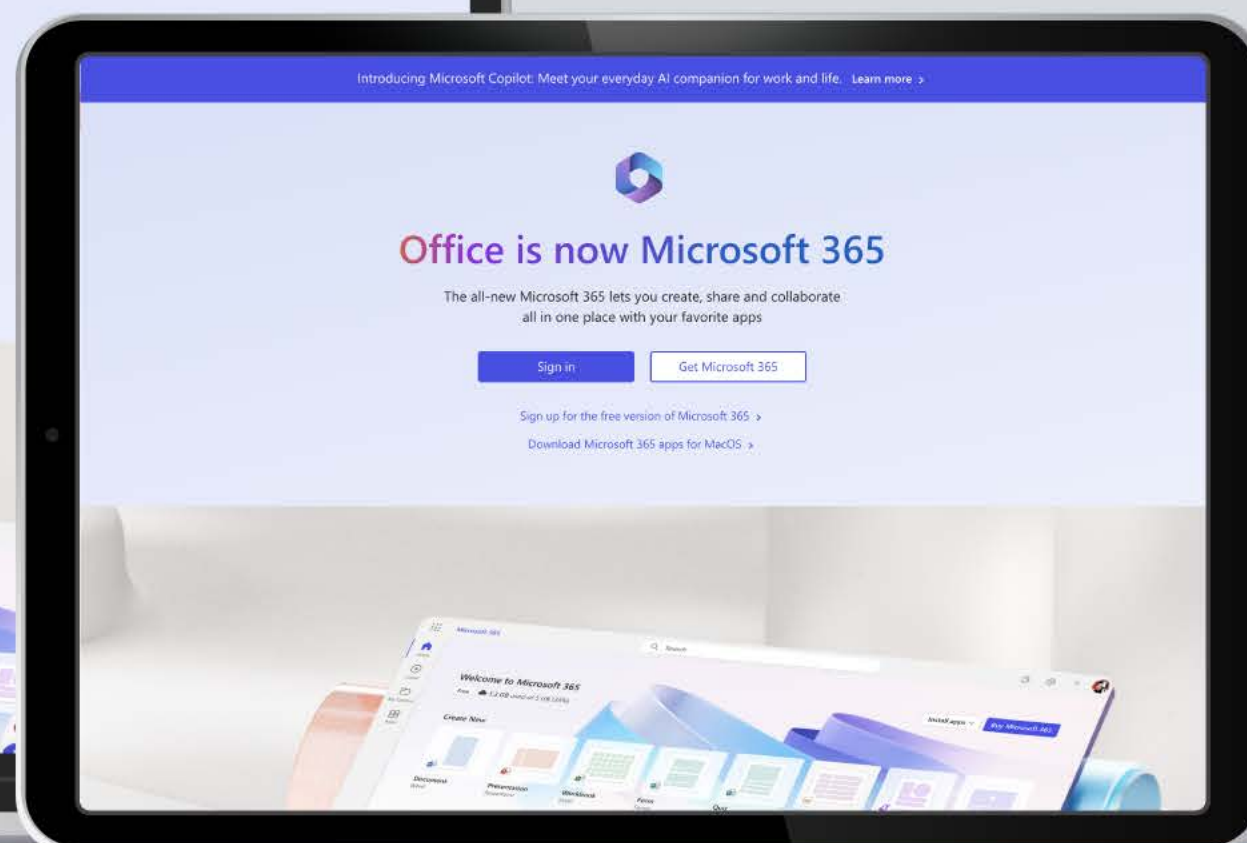
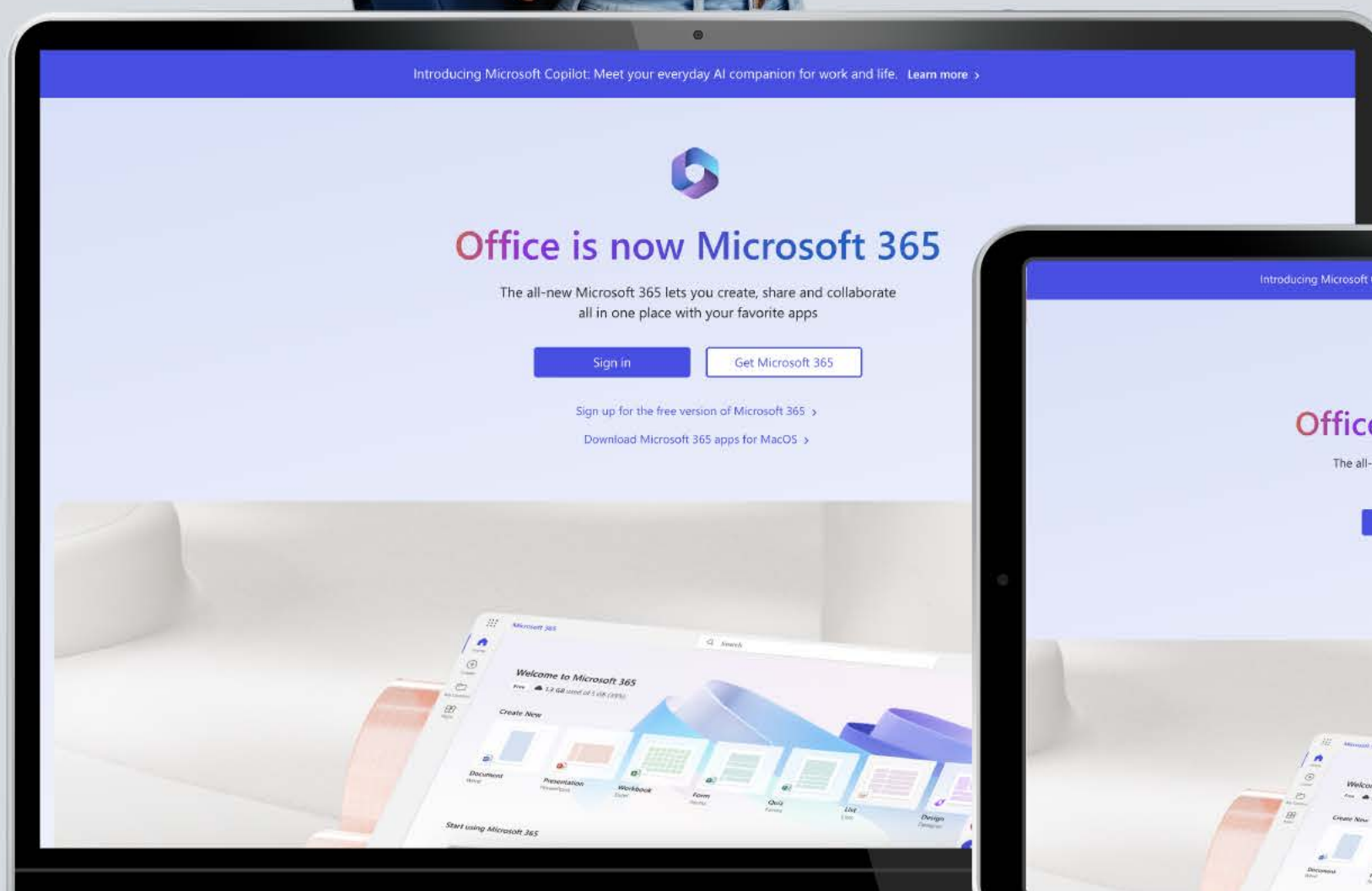

Access rights will be revoked once students graduate.



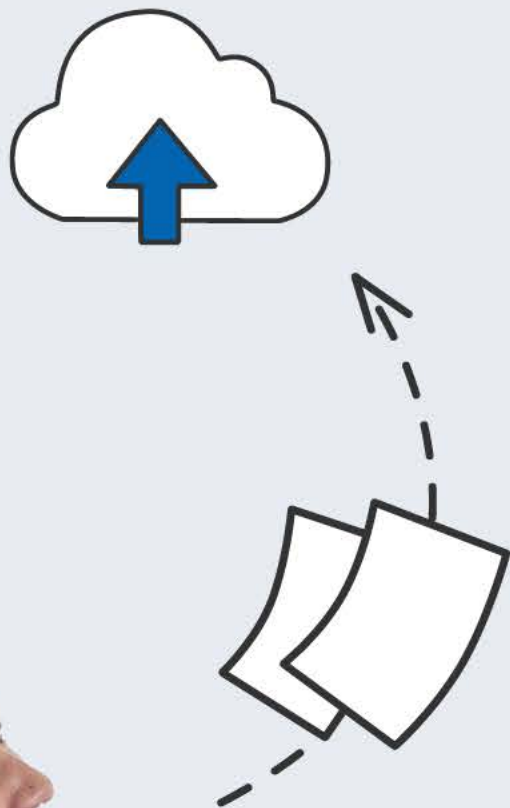


Personal Cloud Storage Service

This service is provided for students of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi, allowing them to share files with others and access files to work from anywhere with an internet connection.

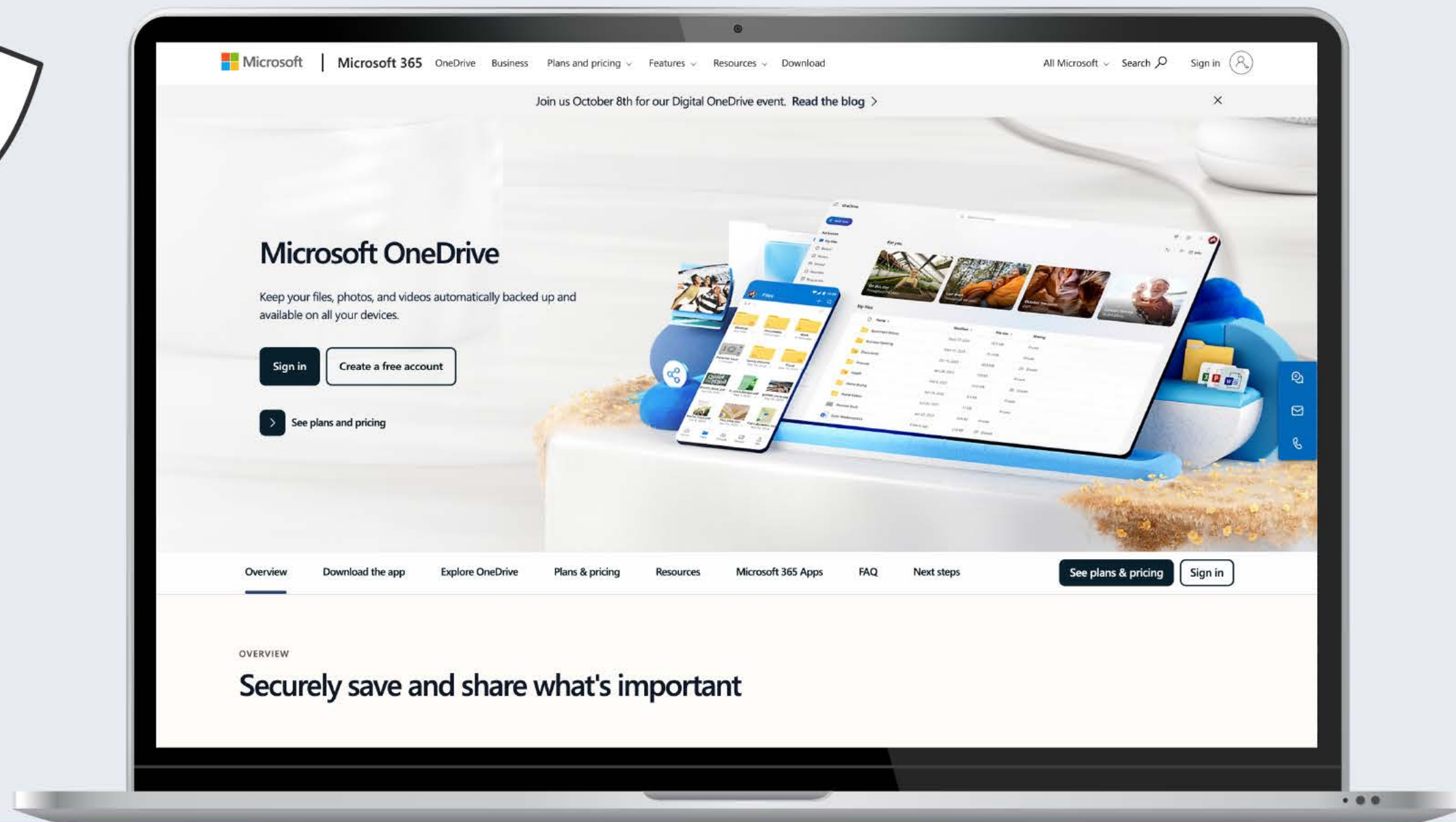
There is a storage space of 10 TB available,

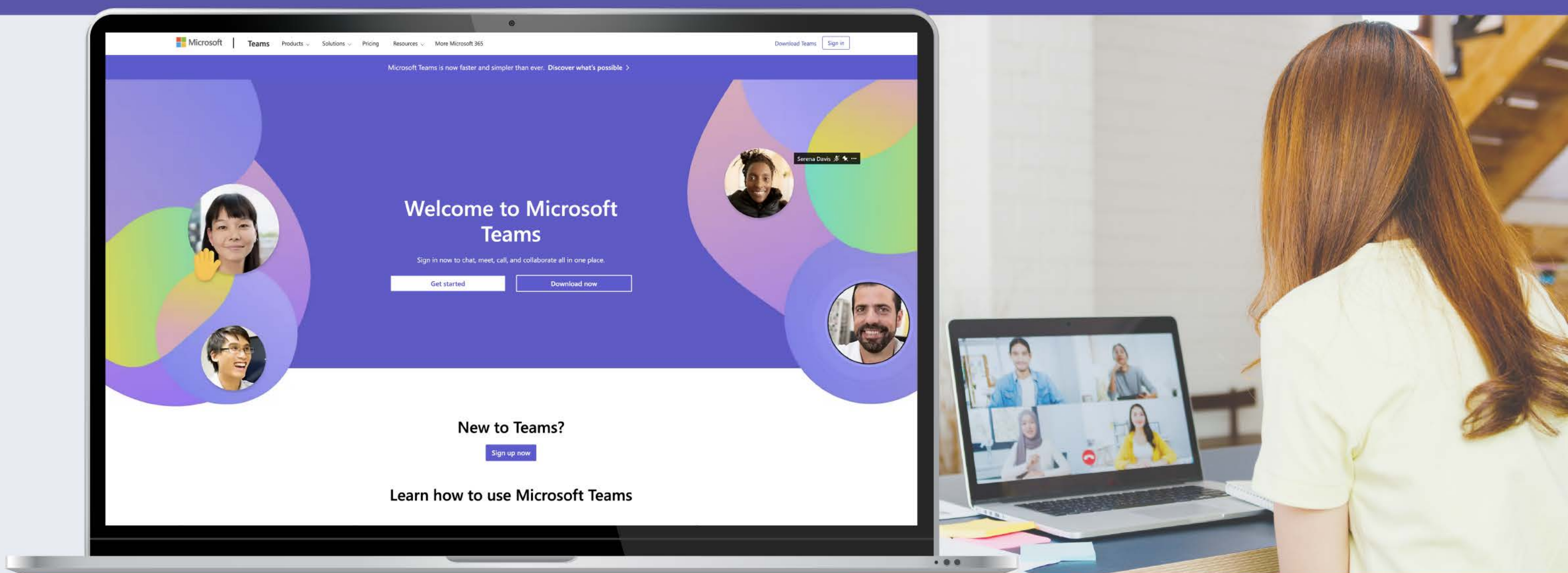
Microsoft Teams is a collaboration app that helps teams stay organized and connected in one place.

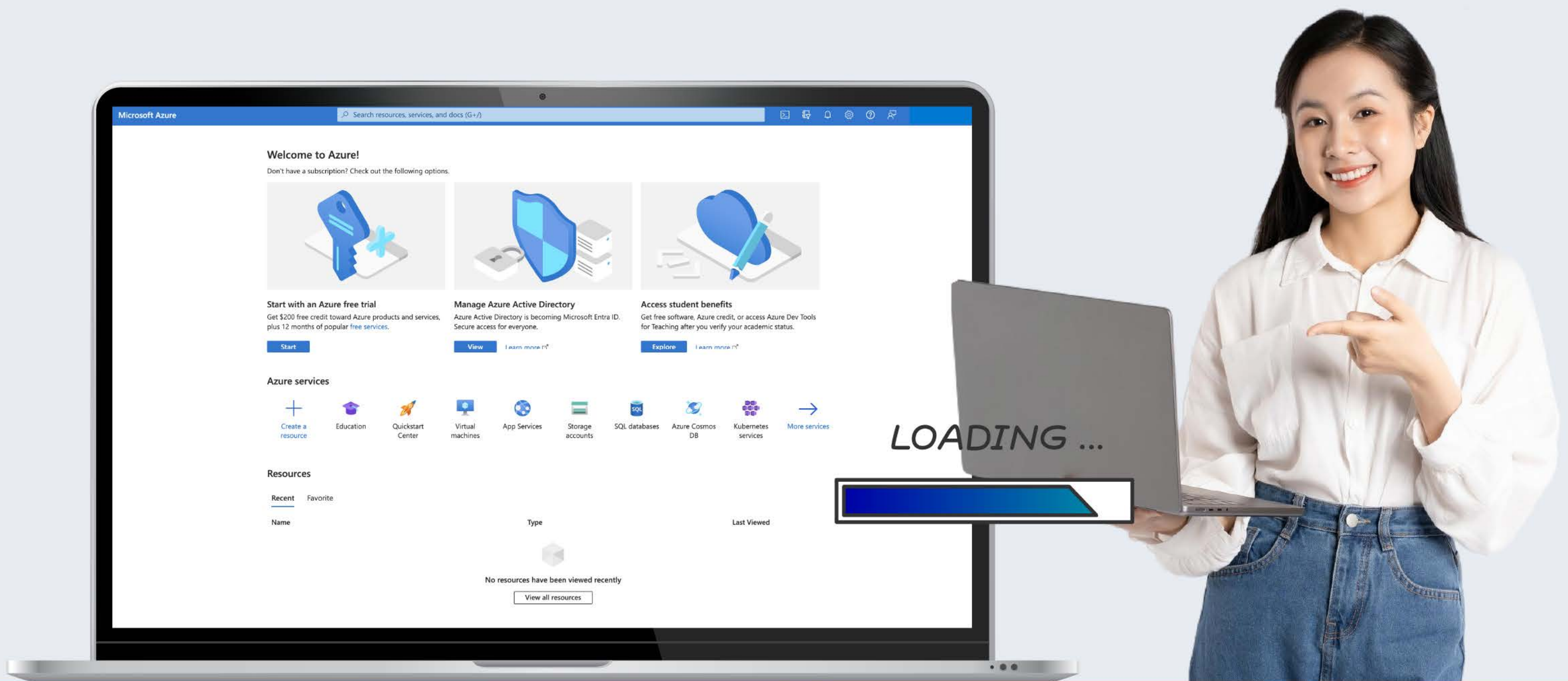

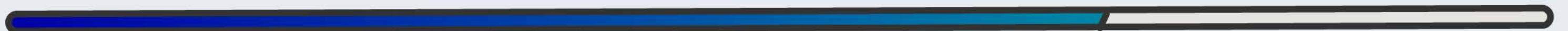

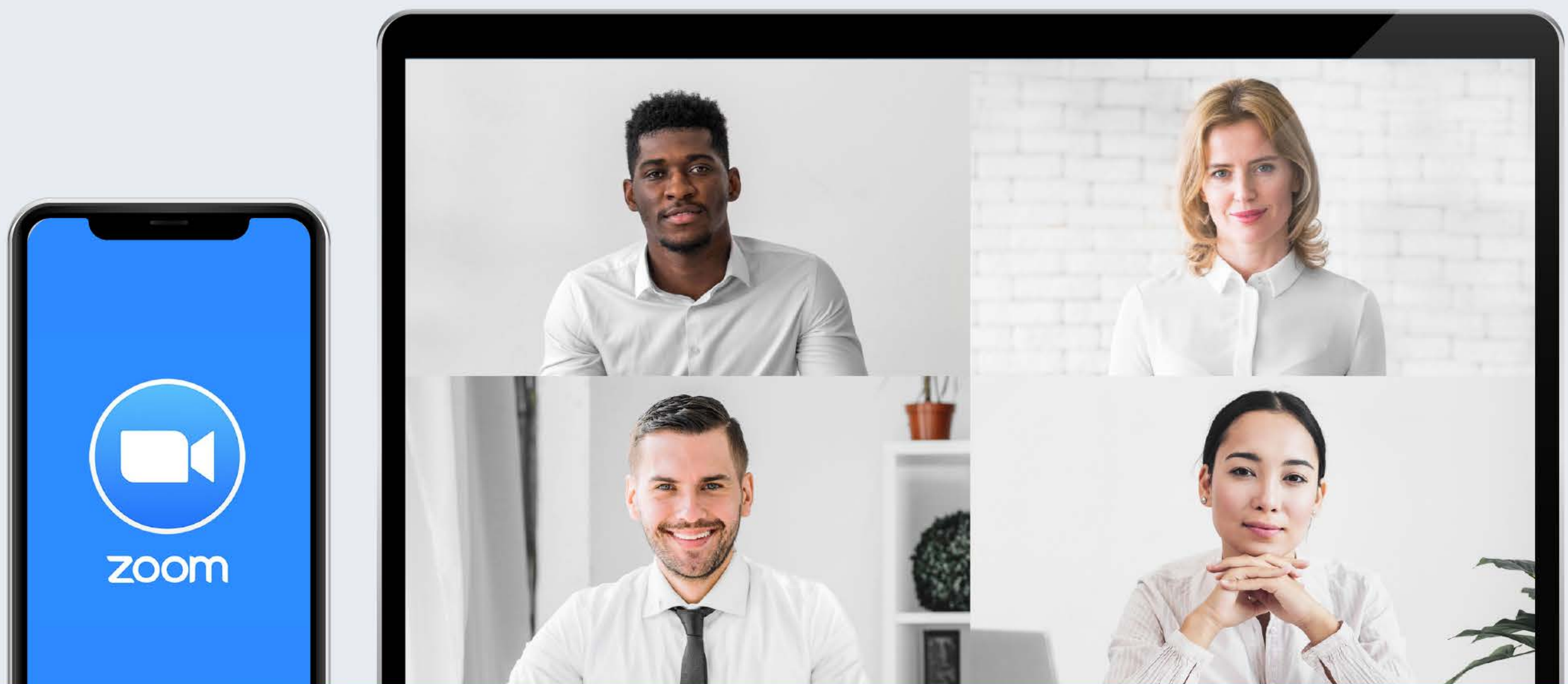
Zoom Cloud Meeting

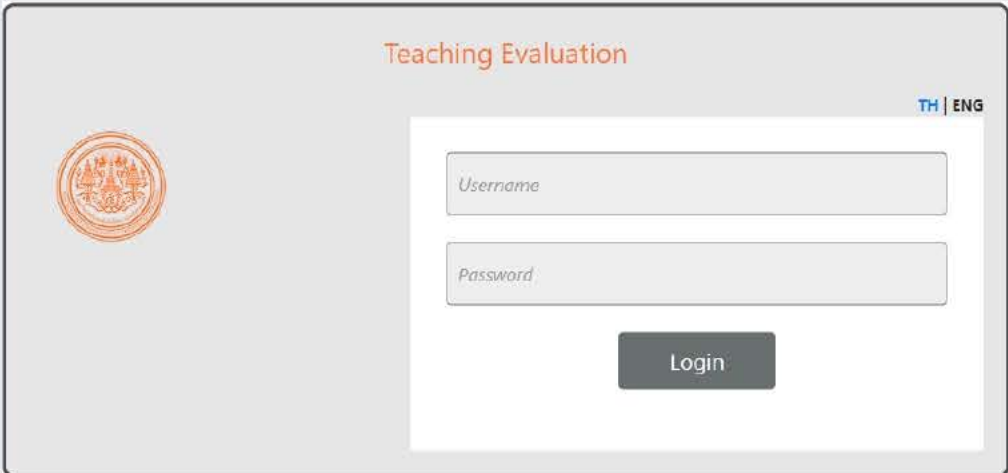
