


- Setup L2TP/IPsec

-Setup L2TP/IPsec


1. Right click the **network** icon which locate in taskbar
2. Select **Network and internet setting**



3. In setting menu click **Network & internet**
4. Select VPN



5. Select **Add VPN**

5.4 VPN type: **L2TP/IPsec with pre-shared key**


5.5 Pre-shared key: **kmutt.ac.th**

5.7 User name (optional) : **username.sur** (EX. Name.sur or 6xxxxxxxxx)


5.8 Password (optional): ********* (same password as your Kmutt Email)

5.9 **Save**




6. Select **Advance network setting**

9. Select **Properties**




10. In **KMUTTVPN Properties** select **Security**

11.1 Select **(•) Allow these protocols**


11.2 Make sure to check box only at **[/] Challenge Handshake Authentication Protocol (CHAP)**

12. Click **OK** to save the setting




-Login process for L2TP/IPsec

3. Click connect at **KMUTTVPN**




-Disconnect from L2TP/IPsec
