
- ➤ Steps for Configuring L2TP/IPsec
- 1.Click on Network from the Taskbar
- 2. Select Open Network and Sharing Center




3. When the Network and Sharing Center window appears, select Set up a new connection or network.



- 4. When the Set up a new connection or network window appears.
  - 4.1 Select Connect to a workplace
  - 4.2 Click Next




5. When the Connect to a Workplace window appears, select Use my Internet connection (VPN).




- 6. When the settings window appears, configure as follows.

Destination name: KMUTTVPN


6.2 Click Create

  - 8.2 Select Properties




- 9. In the KMUTTVPN Properties window, select the Security tab and configure the settings as follows:

The Advanced Properties window appears.


9.3.1 Select Use preshared key for authentication

- 2.Select KMUTTVPN and Click Connect




- 4.Please enter the Username and Password to connect to the VPN.

4.2 Click OK




- ➤ Steps for Disconnecting from L2TP/IPsec
